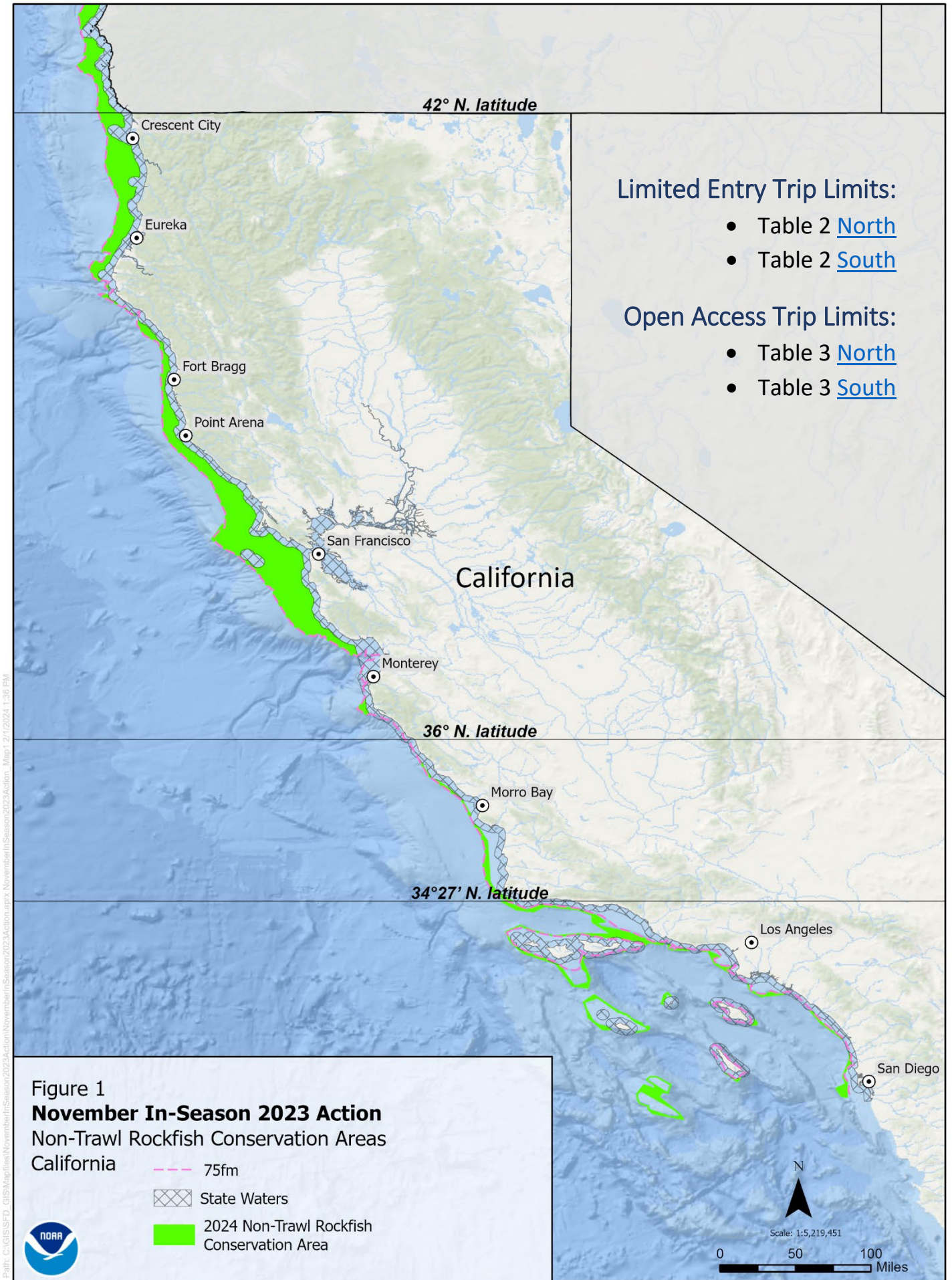

Seaward of the Non-Trawl RCA:

- Typical trip limits available
- Typical gear restrictions

Inside the Non-Trawl RCA:

- Only stationary vertical jig gear or groundfish troll gear (50 CRF 660.330(b)(3))
- No lingcod, minor nearshore rockfish, cabezon or “other flatfish”
- Reduced trip limits for minor shelf rockfish

Shoreward of the Non-Trawl RCA

- See California state regulations

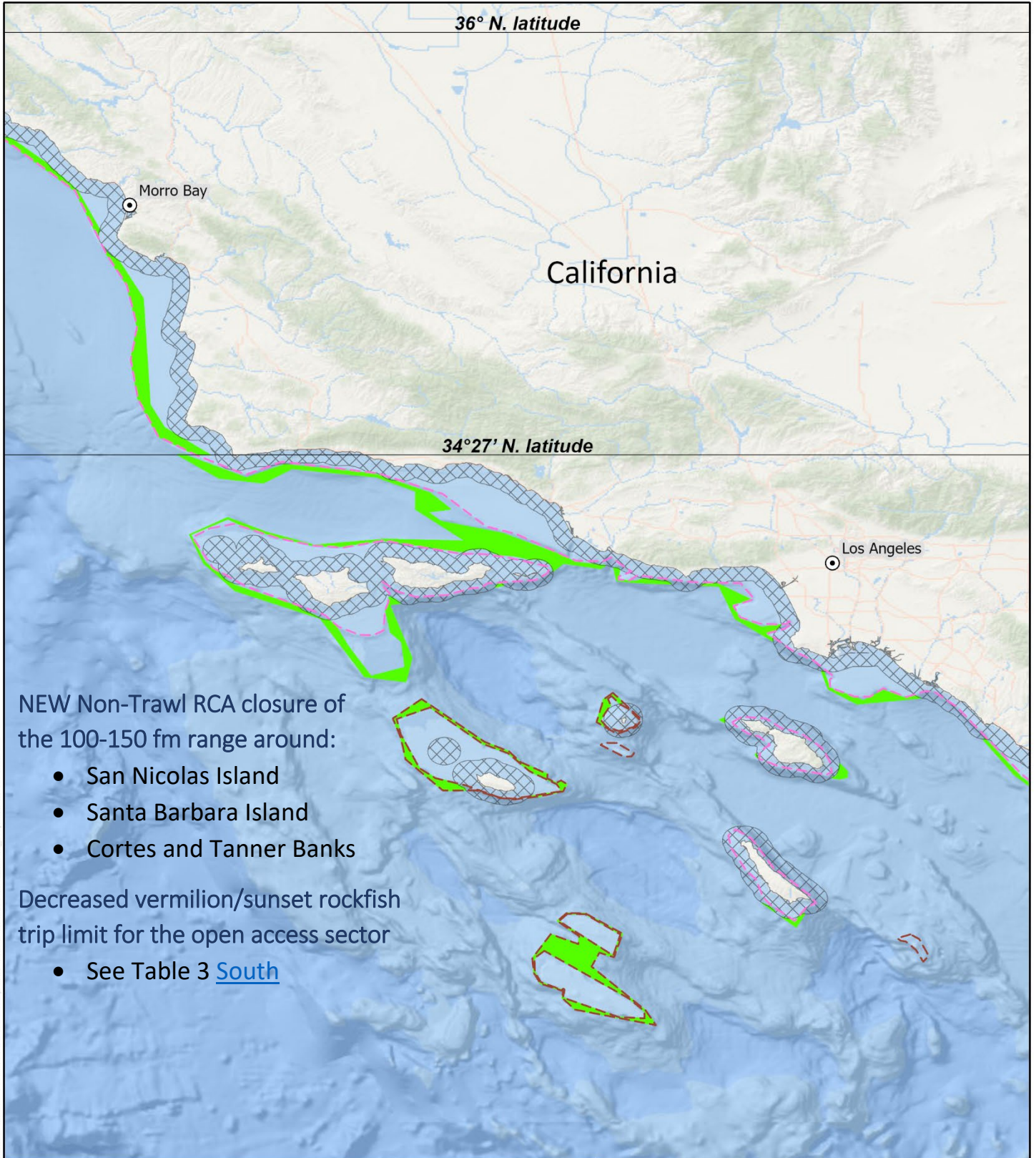
